FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to provide a return on your investment through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets.
- The Fund invests globally at least 80% of its total assets in the equity securities (i.e. shares) of companies globally that benefit from, or contribute to, the advancement of the "Circular Economy". The Circular Economy concept recognises the importance of a sustainable economic system and aims to minimise waste by considering the full lifecycle of materials, and redesigning products and operations to encourage greater reuse and recycling.
- In normal market conditions the Fund will invest in a portfolio of equity securities of companies with large, medium and small market capitalisation (market capitalisation is the share price of the company multiplied by the number of shares issued) that are involved in activities including the following: raw materials (e.g. metals and battery materials), across all industry sectors, that contribute to the advancement of a Circular Economy across three categories as described in the prospectus: (1) Adopters (2) Enablers (3) Beneficiaries. The companies are rated by the investment adviser (IA) based on their ability to manage the risks and opportunities associated with the Circular Economy and on their environmental, social and governance (ESG) risk and opportunity credentials.

GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices. **Article 9:** Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.

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
