FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to maximise the return on your investment through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets and invest in a manner consistent with the principles of environmental, social and governance (ESG) investing.
- The Fund invests at least 70% of its total assets in the equity securities (e.g. shares) of companies domiciled in European Union (EU) Member States participating in the Economic and Monetary Union of the European Union (EMU). This may, at the investment adviser's (IA) discretion, include the equity securities of companies domiciled in countries which formerly participated in EMU or are likely to join the EMU in the foreseeable future and in companies based elsewhere, the main business of which is in EMU-participating countries.

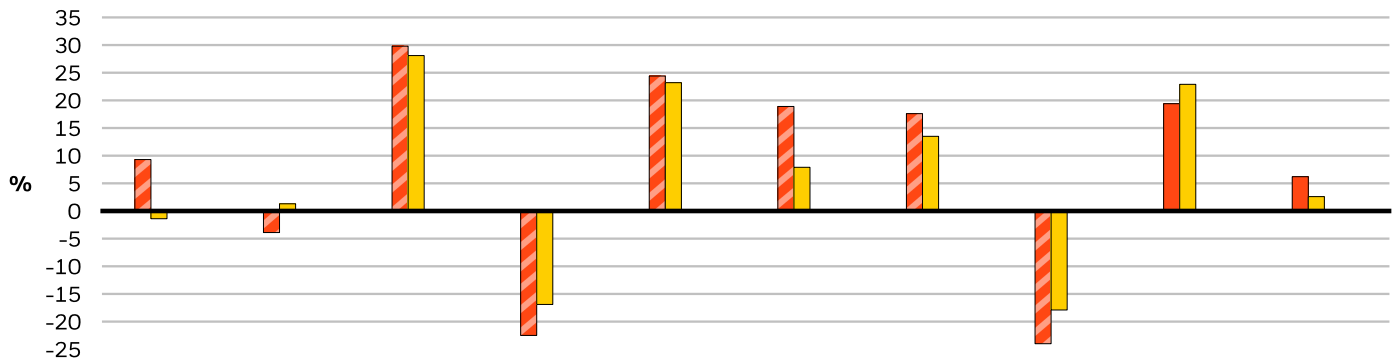

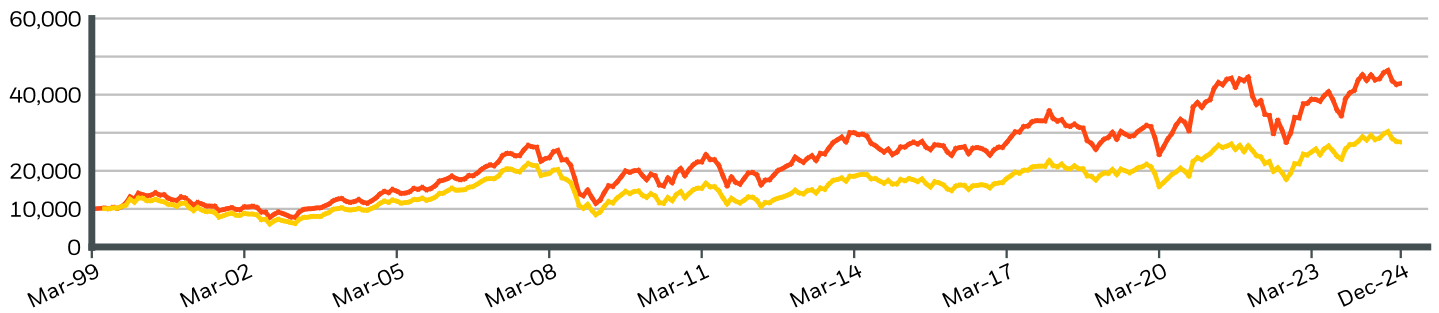

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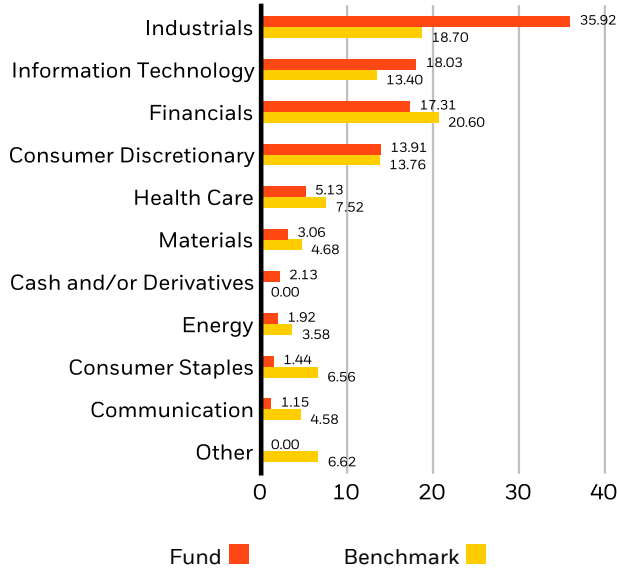

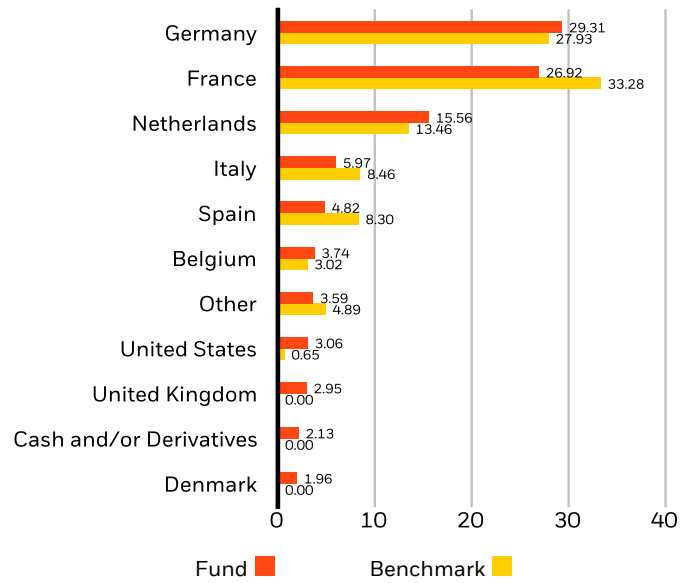

SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)



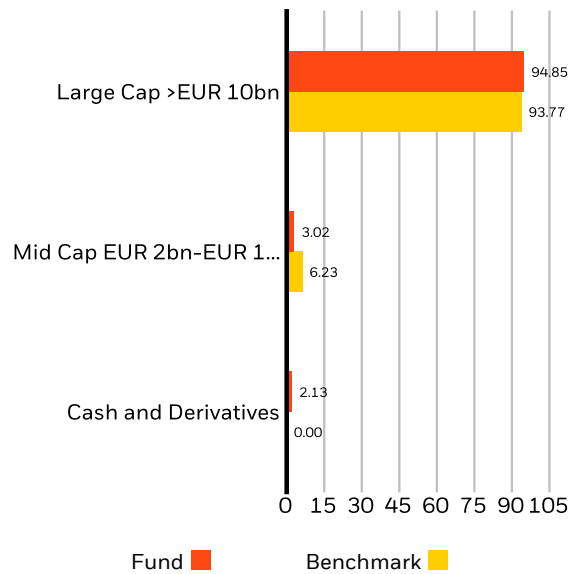
