FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to maximise the return on your investment through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets in a manner consistent with the principles of sustainable and environmental, social and governance (ESG) focused investing.
- The Fund invests globally at least 70% of its total assets in fixed income securities.
 These include bonds and money market instruments (i.e. debt securities with short
 term maturities). The Fund's base currency is Euro and currency exposure is flexibly
 managed.
- The asset allocation of the Fund will reflect its Euro base currency and consequently the composition of the portfolio may be different to that of a similar fund with a US Dollar denominated base currency.

KEY RISKS:

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GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices. **Article 9:** Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Yield to Maturity: Yield to Maturity (YTM) is the discount rate that equates the present value of bond's cash flows with its market price (including accrued interest). The fund YTM is the weighted average of fund's individual bond holding YTMs based upon Net Asset Value ('NAV'). The measure does not include fees and expenses. For callable bonds, YTM is the Yield-to-Worst.

Data Coverage % is available input data for rating calculation at the Pillar level

Effective Duration: Effective duration is a measure of a fund's interestrate sensitivity. Put simply, the longer a fund's duration, the more sensitive the fund is to shifts in interest rates. So a fund with a duration of 10 years is twice as volatile as a fund with a five-year duration.

Analyst Driven % is the analyst input into the overall rating assignment, including direct analyst coverage and inheritance of an analyst-rated pillar
