#### **FUND OVERVIEW**

- The aim of the Fund is to provide, over a period of 7 years, a return on your investment (generated through an increase in the value of the assets held by the Fund and/or income received from those assets) of 4.5% per year on a gross basis (i.e. before deduction of Ongoing Charges) over the Bank of England's Base Interest Rate (as set by the Monetary Policy Committee) in a manner consistent with the principles of environmental, social and governance (ESG)-focused investing.
- In addition, the Fund aims to manage its portfolio of investments with a view to having a volatility of return (i.e. the degree of fluctuation of the Fund's returns) that is lower than the volatility of the monthly returns (converted into an annual rate) of the MSCI All Country World Index (GBP) over a 7 year period. The MSCI All Country World Index (GBP) measures the performance of large and mid-capitalisation developed and emerging market equities in Pound Sterling terms. Although the Fund aims to achieve its investment objective, there is no guarantee that this will be achieved and the Fund may experience loss and/or higher or lower volatility of return. The investment manager (IM) will typically determine the Fund's portfolio based on its long-term (5-7 year) outlook.
- The Fund invests on a global basis directly, or indirectly through derivatives and funds, in fixed income securities (such as bonds), money-market instruments (i.e. debt securities with short term maturities), equity securities (e.g. shares), derivatives (i.e. investments the prices of which are based on one or more underlying assets), funds, deposits and cash. The fixed income securities and money-market instruments will be issued by governments, government agencies, companies and supranationals (e.g. the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development) and may include investments with a relatively low credit rating or which are unrated.





- Credit Risk: The issuer of a financial asset held within the Fund may not pay income or repay capital to the Fund when due. If a financial institution is unable to meet its financial obligations, its financial assets may be subject to a write down in value or converted (i.e. "bail-in") by relevant authorities to rescue the institution.
- Liquidity Risk: Lower liquidity means there are insufficient buyers or sellers to allow the Fund to sell or buy investments readily.



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#### **GLOSSARY**

**Average Market Cap:** The average market capitalization of a fund's equity portfolio gives you a measure of the size of the companies in which the fund invests. Market capitalization is calculated by multiplying the number of a company's shares outstanding by its price per share.

**Price to Book Ratio:** represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.

**Modified Duration:** A measure of price sensitivity of a bond to changes in interest rates. The Modified Duration of the fund is calculated as the average of the underlying bonds' modified duration values, adjusted to take account of their relative weight (size) within the fund.

**Price to Earnings:** A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.
