FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to provide a return on your investment (generated through an increase in the value of the assets held by the Fund) over the long-term (5 years or more).
- The Fund invests at least 80% of its assets in equity securities (e.g. shares) and equityrelated securities of companies domiciled in, or whose main business is in, global
 developed markets. The Fund may also, when determined appropriate, invest in other
 equity securities and equity-related securities and other asset classes to seek to
 achieve its investment objective and for liquidity purposes.
- The Investment Manager (IM) uses fundamental, company specific research to identify
 and select securities that, in its opinion, have the potential to produce attractive longterm growth. The Fund's portfolio is expected to be concentrated (i.e. a less diverse
 portfolio). The Fund has an unconstrained investment style (i.e. it will not take a
 benchmark index into account when selecting the Fund's investments).

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GLOSSARY

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.

Analyst Driven % is the analyst input into the overall rating assignment, including direct analyst coverage and inheritance of an analyst-rated pillar

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

Data Coverage % is available input data for rating calculation at the Pillar level
