FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to maximise the return on your investment through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets in a manner consistent with the principles of environmental, social and governance (ESG) investing as disclosed in the Prospectus. - The Fund invests in the range of eligible assets for UCITS funds across the full capital structure of companies (i.e. debt and equity), and securities issued by governments and government agencies. Financial derivative instruments (FDIs) may be used to help achieve the Fund's investment objective. FDIs are investments the prices of which are based on one or more underlying assets.
- The Fund will invest at least 65% of its total assets in fixed income (FI) and FI related securities which may include investments with a relatively low credit rating or which are unrated. The Fund may invest up to 35% of its total assets in equity and equity-related securities.

KEY RISKS:

- Changes to interest rates, credit risk and/or issuer defaults will have a significant impact on the performance of fixed income securities. 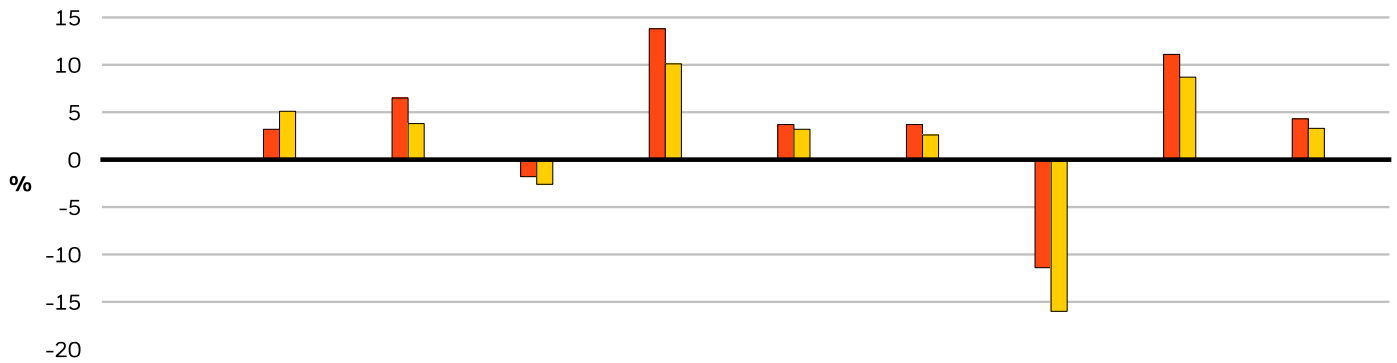

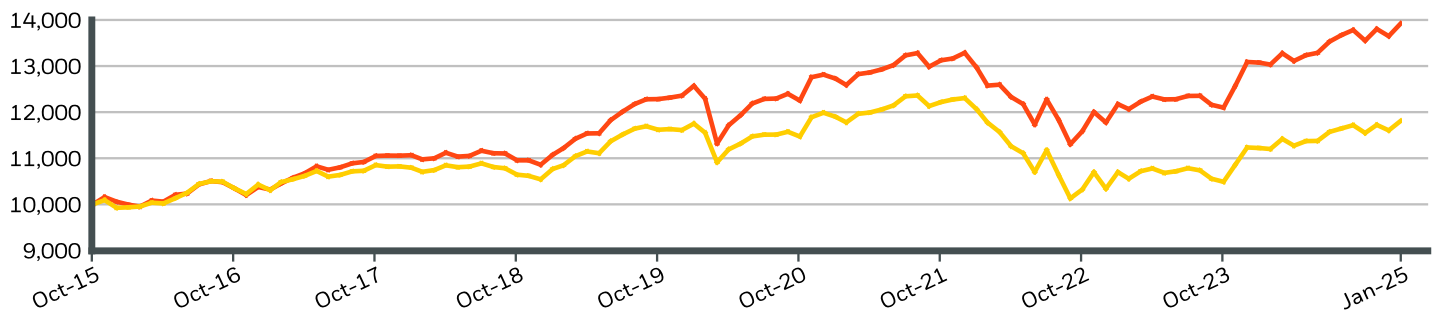

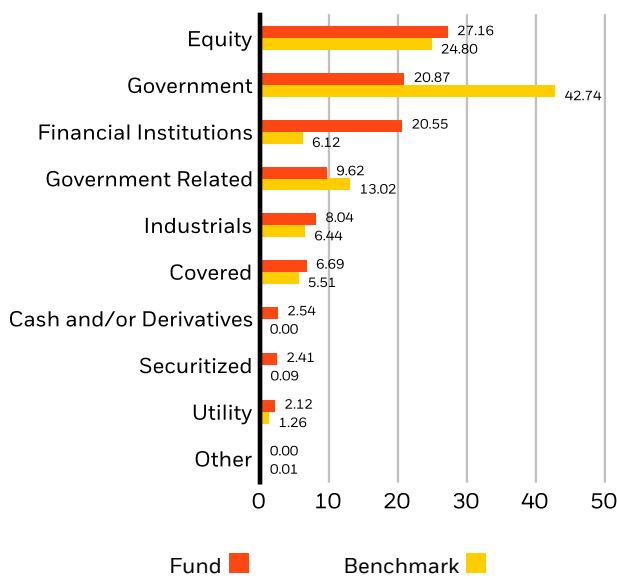

MATURITY BREAKDOWN (%)

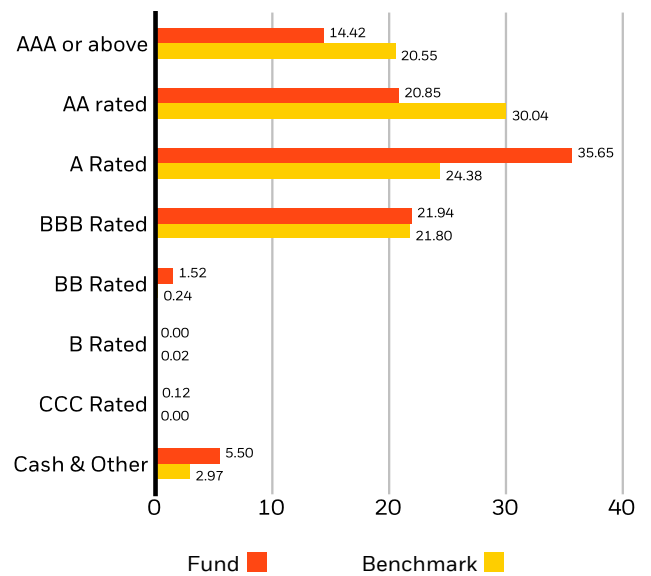

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GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices.

Article 9: Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Yield to Maturity: Yield to Maturity (YTM) is the discount rate that equates the present value of bond's cash flows with its market price (including accrued interest). The fund YTM is the weighted average of fund's individual bond holding YTM's based upon Net Asset Value ('NAV'). The measure does not include fees and expenses. For callable bonds, YTM is the Yield-to-Worst.

Effective Duration: Effective duration is a measure of a fund's interest-rate sensitivity. Put simply, the longer a fund's duration, the more sensitive the fund is to shifts in interest rates. So a fund with a duration of 10 years is twice as volatile as a fund with a five-year duration.
