


SEPARATELY MANAGED ACCOUNTS

Enhanced Short Term Municipal Fixed Income

INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The strategy has a primary investment objective preservation of principle with a secondary objective of after-tax income. The investment approach is flexible and tactical by investing approximately 80% in individual, high quality municipal bonds managed as an active intermediate portfolio. Approximately 20% of the strategy is invested in tax exempt BlackRock Allocation Target Share (BATS) management-fee waived fixed income mutual funds. The BATS are used to target specific segments of the municipal market. The overall portfolio duration range is generally between 1 and 4 years. The principal risks of the strategy are Credit Risk; Liquidity Risk; Counterparty Risk. More detailed information on this strategy is available upon request.

Credit quality ratings on underlying securities of the holdings within the portfolio are received from S&P, Moody's and Fitch and converted to the equivalent S&P major rating category. This breakdown is provided by BlackRock and takes the median rating of the three agencies when all three agencies rate a security, the lower of the two ratings if only two agencies rate a security, and one rating if that is all that is provided. Unrated securities do not necessarily indicate low quality. Below investment-grade is represented by a rating of BB and below. Ratings and portfolio credit quality may change over time.
